151,200 packages of 2 oz sliced apples were distributed to Michigan's food banks to supplement summer lunch programs.



\$50,000 in gas cards were given out at Thanksgiving to provide extra relief to Detroit families.



1,000 Labor Day BBQ meal kits were distributed at our holiday event.



1,000 Thanksgiving meal kits were distributed to 1,000 families for the 10th year.



Over 400 people at Development Center's (now MiSide) Family Fun Day were treated to lunch.



12 months of Hello Bello diapers and baby wipes were awarded to one deserving Head Start family.

#### Summer Program

In order to supplement summer feeding programs throughout the state, we have once again partnered with the Food Bank Council of Michigan. In 2023 we delivered 151,200 packages of apples which were distributed to Michigan's food pantries, shelters, and soup kitchens.



#### Labor Day BBQ

For the third year in a row, meal kits were distributed to 1,000 Detroit families for a Labor Day celebration. Each recipient received enough meat, spices, and sides to enjoy a BBQ with family and friends.



### 1,000 Turkeys, 10,000 Smiles

A major milestone, we celebrated our 10th Thanksgiving meal pass out this year! 1,000 families with children enrolled in Head Start or Brilliant Detroit received everything needed for a Thanksgiving feast. We also presented each family with a \$50 gas card.




